plant	A living thing that grows in one place.
root	This acts as an anchor, fixing the plant to the ground. They absorb water and minerals to help the plant grow.
stem	Leaves and flowers grow from it. It transports water and minerals around the plant.
leaves	Leaves absorb sunlight and turn it into energy that the plant uses to grow.
seed	The small part of a flowering plant that grows into a new plant.
deciduous	A tree that sheds its leaves in Autumn.
evergreen	A tree that keeps its leaves all year round.
carnivore	An animal that eats only meat
herbivore	An animal that eats only plants
omnivore	An animal that eats both meat and plants
mammal	Has fur or hair and a backbone. Babies are born alive and fed milk
bird	Has a beak, wings and 2 legs. They have feathers and lay eggs
Amphibian	Lives on land or in water. Lay eggs in water.
Autumn	Colder weather in Autumn. Leaves fall off deciduous trees.
Winter	Coldest weather in Winter. Shortest days. Some animals hibernate.
Spring	Warmer weather in Spring. Leaves begin to grow, blossom seen on trees. Many baby animals and birds are born.
Summer	Warmest weather in Summer. Longest days.
weather	Wind, rain, sun, fog, snow
