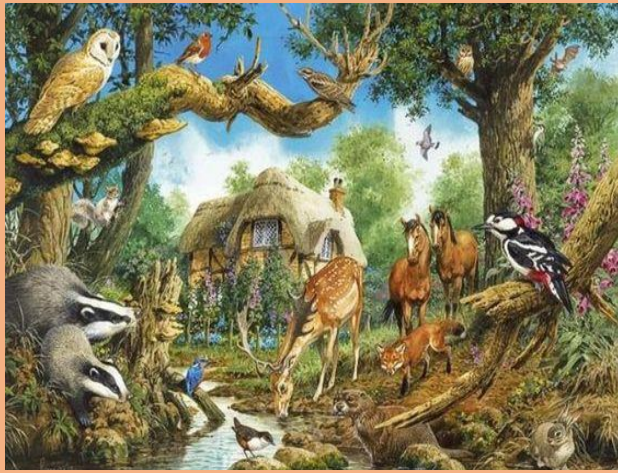

**Key Vocabulary**

<b>plant</b>	A living thing that grows in one place.
<b>root</b>	This acts as an anchor, fixing the plant to the ground. They absorb water and minerals to help the plant grow.
<b>stem</b>	Leaves and flowers grow from it. It transports water and minerals around the plant.
<b>leaves</b>	Leaves absorb sunlight and turn it into energy that the plant uses to grow.
<b>seed</b>	The small part of a flowering plant that grows into a new plant.
<b>deciduous</b>	A tree that sheds its leaves in Autumn.
<b>evergreen</b>	A tree that keeps its leaves all year round.
<b>carnivore</b>	An animal that eats only meat
<b>herbivore</b>	An animal that eats only plants
<b>omnivore</b>	An animal that eats both meat and plants
<b>mammal</b>	Has fur or hair and a backbone. Babies are born alive and fed milk
<b>bird</b>	Has a beak, wings and 2 legs. They have feathers and lay eggs
<b>Amphibian</b>	Lives on land or in water. Lay eggs in water.
<b>Autumn</b>	Colder weather in Autumn. Leaves fall off deciduous trees.
<b>Winter</b>	Coldest weather in Winter. Shortest days. Some animals hibernate.
<b>Spring</b>	Warmer weather in Spring. Leaves begin to grow, blossom seen on trees. Many baby animals and birds are born.
<b>Summer</b>	Warmest weather in Summer. Longest days.
<b>weather</b>	Wind, rain, sun, fog, snow
